Ivan Dilber is a web developer from Belgrade, Serbia. After more than 12 years of working as programmer and web developer in a number of positions ranging from senior PHP developer to managing partner, Ivan started his own company in mid 2009. Since then he has had a privilege to work with a number of satisfied clients, and we will list a few of the most important here:

2010:

- Kurir newspapers website (<http://www.kurir-info.rs>) –Kurir is one of the most popular daily newspapers in Serbia, and their previous website wasn't cut for the their growing traffic and big Internet ambitions they had. Ivan was sub-contracted by a partner to develop the complete website, based on visual solution provided by BgDream studio. This included developing the full front-end (design and scripting) and also back-end solution for content management (CMS), and also search engine optimization (SEO), database and performance optimization, as well as migration of existing data into the new system.
- AdriaMedia Photo-archive application (<http://www.adriamediaphoto.com>) – Digital assets management (DAM) system for managing a huge photo archive of AdriaMedia publishing group. The application was created for AdriaMedia Serbia, and later installed in AdriaMedia Croatia and AdriaMedia Slovenia as well.
- Cosmos-street travel website (<http://cosmos-street.com>) – Privately held website dedicated to travelers. Ivan was commissioned to both design and develop the website, as well as to create a visual identity solution (logo and business cards design). The site includes a number of advanced geo-targeting and mapping solutions to allow for easy creating of tour guides and city reviews. The site was finished in time and it's available online, but due to financial problems, the owners still haven't fully launched it (only content on the site is the one used for testing)
- "Thread and Sugar" beauty salon & beauty products online shop (<http://www.threadandsugar.com/>) – Shopping -cart and payment solution for Thread and Sugar salon in Fresno, California. Ivan was initially hired to fix some problems in the existing flash website, and later worked with them on adding a number of enhancements such as: a complete shopping solution integrated with PayPal payment gateway, system of product categories for

easier navigation, back-end for content management, product gallery management, etc. We are currently preparing the launch of 2 more websites that Ivan will be developing for them.

- Imaago website (<http://imaago.ch/>) – Flash website developed for Imaago Associates, a small Swiss based company. Ivan's part of work was to develop a website based on the design provided by the clients.
- House of Shakti website (<http://www.houseofshakti.com>) – Online jewelry shop. Ivan worked on implementing the design and integration of their shop with existing OSCommerce system.
- Kundalini Seattle (<http://www.kundaliniseattle.com>) – A small yoga related website. Developed the back-end for content management (CMS) and implemented the design provided by the client. Please note: The client has introduced some changes to the site since it was created, so the current state of the site is not entirely the one that was produced by Ivan. A few pages look broken at the moment, perhaps they are still working on them.

2009:

- AskGamblers (<http://askgamblers.com>) – Casino related website that won the “The best casino affiliate site in the world” title in 2009. Ivan was in charge of maintenance and also worked on optimization of the existing website, as well as on re-design of some site sections (games and bonuses). He has also developed a number of back-end tools for easier site management.
Please note: Due to laws regulating online gambling, this site might not be available in some countries (e.g. visitors from Serbia are blocked, as by Serbian laws it is illegal for them to gamble online)
- ChessEmpires (<http://chessempires.com>) – Online multiplayer chess game & social network for chess players. Ivan was the project leader and worked on planning & developing the complete back-end solution and later on performance optimizations. This site is available online, but due to financial problems the client has never fully launched it.
- IPMS –web-based application for CRM, developed for an international law firm.

Ivan has also collaborated with a number of agencies & design studios on a number of projects as a sub-contractor: CeSID.org website redesign, Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Serbia's website development (www.mpravde.gov.rs), www.svezagradjevinu.com web portal development, www.svezavencanje.com design, etc.
